# NPSG85/25 Apologies

# NPSG88/25 Meeting Minutes 30 September 2025

## NPSG89/25 Cycle route update

The Steering Group was advised that the Town Council endorsed the inclusion of the proposed cycle route as a priority for the NPS at the Council meeting held the previous evening. With reference to the draft letter the Council has requested an amendment to include a sentence about the link to the National cycle way.

Sally Atkins joined the meeting.

David updated the meeting on his recent meetings with the two landowners between the National Trust and the Duchy of Cornwall. David & Andrew updated the Steering Group on a proposed amendment to the route which would be beneficial to cyclists.

# NPSG90/25 NPS – Initial document draft

As Shaun had been unable to attend the meeting it was agreed to defer this agenda item to the next meeting.

# NPSG91/25 NPS – Environment

It was agreed to defer this agenda item to the next meeting.

# NPSG92/25 NPS – Housing

It was agreed that some parameters might be brought forward from the Neighbourhood Development Plan namely:-

- The preference for mixed housing on each site
- No building in Flood Zone 2 or 3
- Free standing separate new villages or separate clusters of new development would increase pressure on car parking
- The skyline should be protected from intrusive development
- HH5 Off-street parking requirements In addition to any garage space that may be provided, proposals for housing development will be required to provide a minimum of one off-street parking space for units with 1-2 bedrooms and a minimum of two off street parking spaces for units with 3 or more bedrooms. Proposals for housing developments of four or more dwelling units will also be required to provide one further off-street visitor parking space per four dwelling units.

It was further decided that the next meeting would focus on identifying potential sites for development on a map using the suggested criteria. It was acknowledged that there may be a need to weight the criteria and the criteria list itself might be subject to change, if when undertaking the practical exercise, the initial criteria selected are considered inadequate.

## Suggested criteria

Flooding – Exclude Flood zones 2 & 3 Drainage & Slope Green skyline vista

Site access
Existing features e.g. PROW, Ancient trees
Existing physical infrastructure i.e. drainage
Connectivity to current Town boundary
Current environmental impact & ecological value of the location
Maintain and enhance nature corridors
